Why do a Landscape Design?

How Does The Sprigs & Twigs Landscape Design Process Work?

There are several steps in our design process:

1. **Customer Consultation-** I meet with you for several hours at your site, and discuss your objectives, ideas and priorities to come up with a "game plan". This consultation is free-of-charge.
2. **Fixed-Price Design Proposal-** I next submit a fixed-price design proposal to you that describes what I will do and when. This occurs soon after the consultation visit. Designs vary in cost from \$500 and up depending on the size of the project.

3. **Garden Design -** Following your approval of the proposal and receipt of a 50% deposit, we make detailed measurements and take reference photographs. A professional, custom design is then created for you which includes detailed, scaled layout drawings, comprehensive plant lists, a PowerPoint presentation and CD of the design.

4. **Design Presentation –** I present the design to you in your home and review the details of the design features. The balance of the design fee is due at this time.



Since we are a design and installation company, I also give you a fixed-price detailed installation proposal to consider; most installations can be done all at once or in stages over time.
